The Highland County Board of Supervisors would like to express its extreme disappointment with your introduction of SB 1011 "Personal property tax; rate on generating equipment of electric suppliers". This bill was submitted without consulting the County. Both County Administrator Roberta Lambert and Supervisor Jerry Rexrode explicitly told you that Highland does not support the legislation as proposed, specifically the monetary amount.
